MAGNA-SHIELD® RETARDER PLUS

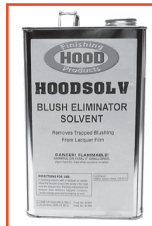

BLUSH ELIMINATOR

Spray over already blushed lacquers. Spray a thin to medium coat over the blushed lacquer. It partially redissolves the lacquer then releases entrapped moisture. Levels orange peel and overspray as well. Contains no retarders. Doesn't leave the film soft. Quick drying.

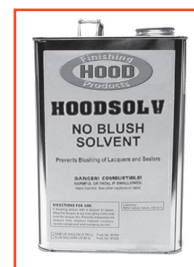

NO BLUSH SOLVENT

Add to conventional lacquers to eliminate blushing in hot and humid weather. Contains no retarders hence will not slow down the drying time nor leave the finish soft. Add 4 to 8 oz. per quart of thinned lacquer or sealer then spray away. Slight blushing may occur on very hot and humid days but will disappear upon drying. Not recommended for Pre-Cat lacquers.

For cleaning of raw or stripped wood and metal prior to finishing or refinishing and, for moisture removal from wood surface prior to refinishing. MEK has a higher flash point than Acetone, hence safer to use.
